The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 14.2.2018, vide which, direction was issued to pay compensation to the petitioner amounting to ₹ 2,25,000/- within a period of four months, failing which the petitioner will be entitled to interest @ 6% per annum.

Reply by way of short affidavit of Sant Ram, Branch Manager, Indian Overseas Bank, Mandi (HP) filed in Court is taken on record. As per the same, the petitioner has been paid compensation of ₹ 2,25,000/- including interest @ 6% per annum as per the order dated 14.2.2018, which amounts to ₹ 13,090/- out of which ₹ 11525/- has already been paid on 23.5.2014.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

In case of any discrepancy in the interest, the petitioner will be at liberty to file a representation, which shall be decided in accordance with law.
