This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing detainee Lakhwinder Kaur from the illegal custody of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Notice of motion was issued.

Alleged detainee-Lakhwinder Kaur has been produced before this Court. She states that she is residing with her parents as per her own consent. She has not been illegally detained by anybody. She also states that petitioner Mandeep had taken her forcibly and kept her under pressure for 2-3 days. She has no relation with petitioner Mandeep and she does not want to go with him. She wants to reside with her parents only.

The alleged detainee-Lakhwinder Kaur is allowed to go with her parents.

In view of the statement made by the detainee, the instant

petition is dismissed with costs of ₹20,000/-. The petitioner is directed to

deposit costs with ld. CJM/Duty Magistrate, Bhiwani within one month which shall be paid to detenue Lakhwinder Kaur.

If petitioner fails to deposit the costs within the stipulated period, then ld. CJM, Bhiwani is directed to get it recovered as arrears of land revenue from the petitioner to be paid to the detenue as per law.
