Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.626 dated 15.11.2018, under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act') (Section 27-A of the Act added later on) registered at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad (Haryana).

This court passed the following order on 14.02.2019 :-

“Contends that the recovery of the alleged contraband against the petitioner is only 2 kgs of poppy husk.

Learned State counsel seeks time to verify the status of previous conviction of the petitioner.

On his request, adjourned to 14.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court and in case he moves an application for bail, he shall be released on

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interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

It has been pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the previous order, the petitioner has surrendered before the learned trial Court and he has been released on interim bail.

The above factual position was duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Bhupinder.

In view of above, the interim order dated 14.02.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is clarified that the petitioner will fully cooperate with the proceedings before the learned trial court and shall not seek any unnecessary adjournment.
