The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that as on today there is no threat to the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Surinder Mohan, PPS ACP (Crime) additional charge as ACP (East), Ludhiana on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 along with joint statement of the petitioners (Annexure R-1/T). The same are taken on record. Copy given to the opposite counsel. He on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh has apprised the Court that both the petitioners in their joint statement mentioned that they do not want any security at present and if they feel any security is required, they will contact the concerned police station.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition as the alleged threat has vanished.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is allowed to be dismissed as withdrawn.
