This revision is directed against the impugned order dated 3rd December, 2018 (Annexures P-8 and P-9) passed by the Ld. Additional District Judge, Gurugram whereby only the question of maintainability of the appeal preferred by the respondents/judgment-debtors against dismissal of their objections by the Executing Court vide Order dated 21st September, 2018 (Annexure P-7) was decided in favour of the appellants.

2. It now transpires that the said appeal is listed for hearing on merits on 28th of this month which happens to be the very first working day of the Court after today.

3. In the given circumstances, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the pending proceedings at this stage, since by issuing notice to the respondents, there is possibility of an unnecessary delay, and even final disposal of the appeal, if contemplated by the Ld. Appellate Court, is also liable to be delayed.

4. Consequently, the revision is disposed off at this stage with a direction upon the Ld. Additional District Judge, Gurugram to decide the pending appeal on the date fixed i.e. 28th January, 2019 itself or as soon as possible thereafter but within a period of two weeks in case the matter is adjourned on the next date.
