Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Vide previous order dated 23.01.2019, notice of motion was issued and the petitioner was sent to protection home at Panchkula under safe custody since the petitioner had apprehension of threat from her parents. Today the police have filed a report based on the statements of the parents of the petitioner. The parents of the petitioner have stated that they had never objected to their daughter's of studies. They intended to get her higher education as well. However, they had come to know that she has performed Court marriage. But even to any such marriage, they did not have any objection. It is stated by them that the petitioner could live her life as per her choice and they had no intention to interfere in the personal life of the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. The petition is dismissed as infructuous.

Let the petitioner be released from the protection home forthwith. She would be free to go wherever she desired.
