By this petition, the petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to regularize his services in view of policy dated 01.10.2003 (Annexure P-1).

The petitioner is working as Labourer on daily wages since January 1998 and has not been regularized keeping in view the policy dated 01.10.2003 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the letter dated 01.08.2014 (Annexure P-3) whereby respondent No. 3 has found that petitioner is fully eligible and entitled for regularization. He further contends that as per the seniority list prepared by Labour Union of Forest Department, name of the petitioner figures at Sr. No. 238 (Annexure P-4). However, juniors to the petitioner have been regularized in the month of July/August 2018. He is seeking benefit of regularization keeping in view the judgment passed by Supreme Court in *Hari Nandan Prasad and another V/s. FCI 2014(2) SCT-234*.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

This petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner at par with the juniors and pass appropriate orders of regularization within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order keeping in view judgment passed in *CWP-2009-2016 Balwinder Singh and others V/s. State of Haryana and others* (Annexure P-6) failing which Rs.50,000/- will be deposited in the account of the petitioner and this Court be informed of the order passed.
