Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.176 dated 16.11.2018 under Sections 326/ 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tran Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that there were inimical relations between the parties as representation dated 03.11.2018 (Annexure P2) was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran by the son of the petitioner and petitioner herself had sustained injuries. More so, the alleged occurrence took place on 01.11.2018 and the matter was reported to the police after 15 days i.e. on 16.11.2018 vide Annexure P3 and she has been falsely implicated in this case because of inimical relations.

Learned State counsel contended that the present petitioner is the main accused in this case who has given *gandasi* blow and the petitioner does not deserved the concession of bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is the main accused in this case who has allegedly caused *gandasi* blow and he would be required for effective investigation proceeding and as such, no case is made out for anticipatory bail and the present petition stands dismissed.
