The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.1082, dated 18.10.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 302, 307, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, namely, Braham Prakash. The allegations against the petitioner are that he was driving the car in which other co-accused had come and was alleged to have conducted *recce* of the area. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over two years and nine months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Inspector Kuldeep Singh states that 04 out of 63 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over two years and nine months,

he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
