Prayer made in the application is for grant of interim bail to petitioner-Jai Kumar alias Bhadur on the ground to attend the last rites of his father.

Learned counsel for petitioner Jai Kumar alias Bhadur contended that the father of the petitioner has died and there is no other adult member in his family to perform the last rites of his father.

Learned State counsel affirms the fact that the father of the petitioner had died.

Having considered the above facts, that the father of the petitioner had died and as per petitioner, there is no other adult member in his family to perform the last rites of his father. As such, present petitioner

Jai Kumar alias Bhadur is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period

of one week with effect from 30.01.2019 till 07.02.2019, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner is ordered to surrender before the jail gate on 08.02.2019.

The present petition stands allowed.
