The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.221, dated 20.10.2018, registered under Sections 420, 465, 466, 471 of the IPC, at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

On the last date, it had been stated that apart from the other facts, the matter had been compromised between the parties. Today, learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, states that the matter has been compromised.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed

that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
