Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to look into the complaints dated 24.08.2018, 31.08.2018 and 31.12.2018 (Annexures P1 to P3) and to provide protection to the life, liberty and property of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.2 has purchased a house in the year 2011 and adjacent to the house of the petitioner, there is another land of one Pawan Kumar measuring about 03 marlas and the petitioners are in possession of the same. It is further submitted that the petitioners have constructed a house on their own land and the respondents are interfering in their possession.

Apparently, the bone of contention between the parties is the 03 marlas of land, which as per the own case of the petitioners in para 2 of the petition is owned by one Pawan Kumar and the petitioners are claiming possession over the same whereas it seems that the private respondent is also staking claim of possession over the same property, therefore, the dispute is purely of civil nature and the petitioners instead

of filing a suit of permanent injunction have rather filed complaints before the police to provide protection to their property. From the complaints, filed by the petitioners, no cognizable offence is made out against the private respondent as the dispute between the parties is purely of civil nature.

For the foregoing reasons, the petition fails and is accordingly dismissed.
