This is a petition for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 222 dated 10.09.2018 registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, for the offence under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC.

Vide order dated 24.01.2019, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurbachan Singh, submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is not required. Moreover, the matter has already been settled between the parties.

In this view of the matter, the petition is allowed. The order dated 24.01.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
