[1]. Petitioner has assailed the order dated 04.05.2017 passed by Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Talwandi Sabo, vide which joint application under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC and Order 1 Rule 10 CPC was allowed.

[2]. After going through the ratio of **Nirmal Singh and others Vs. Tarsem Singh and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 679**, learned counsel for the respondents stated that the plaintiffs be permitted to file separate applications for the relief in question before the trial Court and the same be ordered to be

decided in accordance with law.

[3]. Prayer is innocuous to be granted. Plaintiffs would be entitled to file separate applications for the relief in question. In the event of doing so, trial Court may consider the same in accordance with law. Consequently, the impugned order is set aside. This revision petition is allowed. Plaintiffs may resort to filing of separate applications within 15 days from today.
