Report dated 24.07.2019 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baghapurana has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioners Jasvir Singh @ Seera and Jaswinder Kaur and complainant Sukhwinder Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are

not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 186 dated 21.11.2016 registered at Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga under Sections 452, 354, 506 and 34 IPC all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
