Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 05.11.2018 (Annexure P5), passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Phillaur, whereby petitioners were declared proclaimed offenders in case FIR No. 52 dated 23.04.2018, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 & 149 IPC (Sections 325, 326 & 307 IPC were added lateron) at Police Station Goraya, Police District Jalandhar.
