The grievance of the petitioner is that he is in lawful possession of his residential house bequeathed to him by one Raj Dulari. Respondent No.4 is threatening to dispossess him without any lawful reason. A detailed representation dated 14.1.2019 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted but no action has been taken thereupon to mediate.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Four copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him.

Considering the nature of order being passed, no notice is necessary to be issued to respondent No.4.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider this petition as a representation and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case found necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
