Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was summoned to face trial under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. However, he could not appear in the Court on one date as he had wrongly noted the date and his bail bonds were cancelled.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 28.03.2019, had directed petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, states that petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail in terms of the order dated

09.04.2019.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner, the order dated 28.03.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
