This is a petition for quashing impugned order dated 19.12.2016 whereby the petitioner has been declared a 'proclaimed person'.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Tejinder Singh, E.O. Wing, Moga, has suggested the Court that in case the petitioner surrenders his original passport, the prosecution would have no objection if the impugned order is quashed.

Mr. Bhalla has accepted this condition and undertakes that petitioner would surrender before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate,

Moga, on 06.03.2019 and will surrender his original passport bearing No.G4760135.

On his doing so, he will be allowed to join the trial and his bail bonds be accepted.
