This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code for issuance of an appropriate directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by misusing the police power at the instance of private respondent Nos.4 to 6.

As per the averments, respondent No.4 had worked as domestic servant with late father of petitioner Nos.1 and 2, who had expired on 23.07.2009. It is further pleaded that respondent No.4 had set up a claim to a plot measuring 300 square yards founded on a alleged promise by his Master i.e. late father of petitioner Nos.1 and 2.

It is conceded that the complaint brought by respondent No.4 under Sections 420, 406 and 503 of Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of The **Scheduled** Castes and Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, already stands dismissed vide judgment dated 27.09.2017 (Annexure P-1).

It is alleged that respondent No.4 had previously attempted a

suicide in front of the house of the petitioners. However, it is conceded that as per the version of respondent No.4 himself, he had consumed some substance taking it to be cough syrup.

In view of the above, no ground for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C much less the direction as prayer for, is made out.

Petition is dismissed.
