AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 25.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 27250 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur to consider and decide the legal notice dated 25.3.2017 (Annexure P-5) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within

a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Chander Gaiind, Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur has been filed. Along with the reply, order dated 14.3.2019 has been annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though an order has been passed in compliance of the direction of this court but recovery of fine has not been made yet.

Learned counsel for the State submits that certain clarifications were pending with J.D.C. and the needful amount will be recovered in accordance with law within 8 weeks from today.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, the contempt petition stands disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
