Petitioner-tenant has filed this revision against the judgment of Appellate Authority dated 13.08.2018, dismissing his appeal, affirming the order of learned Rent Controller dated 19.08.2017 whereby he was directed to vacate the demised shop to respondent within two months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not challenge the judgment and order of the authorities below on merits, however, seeks two months time to vacate the demised premises.

In view of above request, petitioner is granted two months time from today to vacate the demised premises, failing which he shall pay mesne profits @ Rs.40,000/- per month. Petitioner is directed to file affidavit in this respect before the executing Court within a week from today.
