Today at the very outset, learned counsel submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to raise all the points raised herein before the trial Court at the appropriate stage including his submission to the effect that the complainant has come forward to state that it was under some mistaken belief that FIR had been got lodged and that now misunderstandings have been resolved and a compromise has been effected.

In view of the aforesaid position, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

Needless to mention that all such pleas, if raised before trial Court shall be considered in accordance with law and disposed of expeditiously.
