The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.90 dated 13.02.2018 under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Rohtak City, District Rohtak.

The operative part of the order dated 24.01.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the FIR, there is no month or year, when the alleged amount of Rs.12.50 lacs was given to the petitioner. Notice of motion for 15.03.2019. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 24.01.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Surinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 24.01.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
