Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0122 dated 13.09.2018 registered under Sections 366/366-A/363 /506 /420 /467 / 468 /471/120-B of IPC at Police Station Sarhali, District TarnTaran.

Vide order dated 25.01.2019 passed by this Court, petitioners were granted ad-interim bail, however, subject to the terms & conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

However, on the adjourned date i.e. 22.04.2019, learned State counsel had submitted that during investigation, petitioner No.1-Paramjit Singh @ Parnam Singh was found innocent, but petitioner No.2-Dalbir Singh @ Beera @ Balbir Singh did not join the investigation. Accordingly, vide order dated 22.04.2019, petitioner No.2 was again directed to appear

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 25.01.2019 & 22.04.2019 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 25.01.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
