ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.334 dated 17.12.2018, under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) later on Sections 34 and 201 IPC added registered at Police Station Civil Lines District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner was driving the scooty while co-accused who was a pillion rider had snatched the purse of the complainant. He contends that FIR is the outcome of misunderstanding between the parties and the matter has now been compromised. The petitioner is 22 years of age and his date of birth is 03.11.1998. He has furnished a copy of the marks obtained by the petitioner in IELTS exam, which is taken on record. He also contends that the petitioner intends to go abroad for pursuing higher studies and he is in custody for over 3½ months since his arrest on 28.12.2018.

Learned counsel for the complainant has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant. The matter has indeed been compromised and he has filed a copy of the affidavit of the complainant in this regard which is also taken on record.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 22 years of age, the matter has been compromised, the petitioner is in custody for over 3½ months and their being no other case pending against him, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Navneet Banger @ Nav is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
