Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.599 dated 15.09.2018, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 406, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 25.01.2019 in the main case, passed the following order:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner places reliance upon order dated 14.1.2019 passed in CrI.Misc.No.M-1192 of 2019 to contend that the person who allegedly impersonated deceased Harkaur has been granted interim bail by this Court.

Notice of motion for 1.4.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 1.2.2019 at 10:00 A.M. and cooperate therewith. In the event of his arrest, he shall

be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to his compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, A.S.I. Virender Singh, who is present in the Court, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 25.01.2019 and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 25.01.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
