Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty as they are facing threats, at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7 as petitioners have solemnized marriage against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has produced a statement of petitioner No.1 wherein she has expressed that there is no threat to the couple. Statement of respondent No.4 (father of petitioner No.1) has already been recorded who has expressed no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, petition is rendered infructuous.
