TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J.

Petitioner is a Co-operative Labour and Construction Society. It has been averred that in the year 2016, certain works were allotted to the petitioner by the Divisional Engineer, Punjab Water Resources Management and Development Corporation Ltd. The details of the work have been furnished in a tabulation in para 2 of the writ petition.

The short grievance raised by the petitioner in the petition is that inspite of the works having been executed as per terms and conditions of the contract, an amount of Rs.10,32,757/- is outstanding and the same is not being released without any justifiable cause.

In view of such limited grievance raised in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition at the very threshold and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition by directing respondent No.3 i.e. the Divisional Engineer, Punjab Water Resources Management and Development Corporation Ltd., to consider the claim of the petitioner/Society against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 20.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) that is stated to have already been submitted and a final decision thereupon be taken expeditiously and in any

case within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that if any amount is found due to the petitioner company, the same would be released without any further delay.
