Petitioner Sawinder Singh alias Happy alias Doctor Mann has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.163 dated 23.09.2018, registered under Sections 304, 313, 314, 201, 120-B IPC, at Police Station B-Division, District Amritsar.

It is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner was known as Dr. Maan and running a clinic in the name of Maan Clinic, Chaba Tarn Taran Road.

The daughter of the complainant namely Amandeep Kaur had come in contact with the petitioner. He developed physical relation with her and due to which she conceived. In order to hide her pregnancy, the petitioner took her in his clinic and performed abortion. Due to the said abortion, the health condition of Amandeep Kaur became deteriorated and ultimately she died. After her death, in order to hide her dead body, the

petitioner with the help of his accomplice wrapped her dead body in a bedsheet and after using his vehicle threw the same at New Shaheed Udham Singh Nagar ground near Dara Motor in the bushes.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

After going through the materials including the medical record available on record; keeping in view the seriousness of the offence and without commenting on the merits of the case, this court is of the opinion that the petitioner is not entitled to grant the concession of regular bail to him.

Consequently, the instant petition stands dismissed.
