TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J.

Petitioner claims himself to be possessing a weapon i.e. 12 Bore, double barrel gun. He was issued arms licence in the year 1992 and which stood renew upto 31.07.2011. His arms licence has been issued by the District Magistrate, Amritsar.

The only grievance raised in the instant petition is that his application for renewal of the arms licence has not been decided by respondent No.3 i.e. Sub Divisional Magistrate, Tehsil Tosham, District Bhiwani. It has been pleaded that respondent No.3 had even addressed communication to District Magistrate, Amritsar and the response was received on 29.06.2017 giving no objection regarding renewal of licence but inspite thereof no final decision has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

He submits that in case any application of the petitioner for renewal of the arms licence is pending, the same would be decided by the concerned authority after examining its maintainability within two months.

In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, no further order is required to be passed.

The writ petition is disposed of.
