The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 1.3.2018 passed by this court in CWP No. 4998 of 2018. The said petition was disposed of in terms of the decision of this Court rendered in CWP No. 25997 of 2016—Mahavir Singh and others v. State of Haryana and others, decided on 10.8.2017.

The grievance is that arrears have not been paid to the petitioners. It is alleged that one relief was given by this court with regard to payment of DC rates was granted by the respondents.

On 20.2.2019, learned counsel appearing for the State of Haryana produced details of payments made to the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners took time to verify the same.

Thereafter, on 25.4.2019, none appeared on behalf of the petitioners as the lawyers were abstaining from work. Today again, none is present for the parties as the lawyers are again abstaining from work.

In view of the above facts, the present contempt petition is disposed of as details were produced stating that arrears have been paid to the petitioners. However, if there is any grievance with regard to calculation, the petitioners would be at liberty to move a representation to the respondents which shall be decided expeditiously in accordance with law after granting an opportunity of hearing.

However, it is made clear that in case there is any discrepancy in details produced before this court, the petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
