This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.518 dated 10.09.2018 registered under Sections 420/406/506/120-B/34 IPC and Sections 4/5/6 Prize Chits and Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act, 1978 at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail application expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the court on or before 02.02.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 04.02.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
