in different jails and they are not produced before the Court.

The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana will ensure that all the
accused be produced before the trial Court on the dates fixed by making

not. If any of the accused is not produced, the trial Court can conduct the
proceedings through video conference as per rules and law.
