Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103 dated 05.04.2018 registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station Kheripul, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the main dispute between the parties have been settled as the payment has been made to the complainant-respondent No.2.

Counsel appearing for the respondent No.2 has accepted the fact that payment has been made to the complainant. This fact has also been verified by the learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is disposed of. Let the petitioner appear before the Court below who shall release him on bail to its satisfaction.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
