The petitioner had filed his nomination papers to contest for the post of Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat, Village Shikar, District Gurdaspur and is aggrieved that his nomination papers were illegally rejected. It is not denied that the elections of the Gram Panchayat have already been concluded as the result of the election was declared on 31.12.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced an order passed by this Court in CWP No.40513 of 2018 titled as “Ranbir Kaur and others Vs. Stated of Punjab and others” on 10.1.2019 which was disposed of with liberty to the petitioners therein to file an election petition. He prays that the present petition may also be disposed of with liberty to file the election petition.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the order dated 10.1.2019 passed in CWP No.40513 of 2018, which read as under: -

“The present writ petition cannot be entertained in view of the availability of alternate remedy by way of election petition. Disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to file election petition. If the same is filed, the Election Tribunal is directed to decide it within a period of one year.”

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.40513 of 2018 titled as “Ranbir Kaur and others Vs. Stated of Punjab and others” on 10.1.2019.
