Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioner and his family.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that an FIR No.146 dated 09.09.2018 under Sections 366 and 366-A IPC has been registered at Police Station City 1, Abohar against Pawan Kumar son of the petitioner at the instance of respondent No.4. He states that the police is visiting the house of the petitioner without there being a notice and the petitioner is not an accused in the said FIR.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Jagmohan Ghumman, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

As per the FIR, the petitioner came to the house of the complainant on the date prior to the registration of FIR. This fact is required to be looked into during the course of investigation. Therefore, without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner is required in the case, the investigating officer shall issue a notice under Section 160 Cr.PC to the petitioner before joining him in the investigation.
