The petitioners apprehend that an FIR would be registered against them and they would be arrested as Kulbir Singh son of Natha Singh has filed a complaint before the police. Hence, the present petition.

The petitioners had approached the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, who had dismissed their application as having been rendered infructuous because the Investigating Officer had made a statement that enquiry was in progress and no FIR had been registered till date.

In view of the aforementioned circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala that in case an FIR is registered against the petitioners and they are sought to be arrested, three days' prior notice shall be given to them.
