On July 1, 2019, this Court has passed the following order:-

“On 27.04.2016, respondent No.1 was reported to have died and therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner was directed to take steps for impleadment of his LRs.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner prays for more time to do the needful.

In the interest of justice, last opportunity is granted to the petitioner to do the needful. However, the same shall be subject to payment to Rs.5,000/- as costs, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association Employees Welfare Fund, Chandigarh.

Adjourned to 20.11.2019.

It is made clear that if the no steps are taken for impleading the LRs of respondent No.1 before the adjourned date, the present petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non prosecution”.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the communications by her to her client have gone unresponded.

It seems that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the present litigation.

The awarded costs have also not been paid.
