In the present writ petition, the grievance raised by the petitioner is that though he retired on 30.06.2017, even upto now his leave encashment has not been released by the respondents without any valid justification.

Counsel for the petitioner further states that there was no justifiable reason with the respondents to withhold the said benefits as there was no proceeding pending against the petitioner, which would have entitled the respondents to withhold the pensionary benefits.

Counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been sought in the present writ petition, the petitioner has made the representations dated 30.01.2018 and 12.12.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-3), respectively, which are still pending

consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representations.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the representations dated 30.01.2018 and 12.12.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to him within a period of next three months.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
