Counsel for the applicant-appellant prays for withdrawal of the applications as well as the main appeal in the light of the development which has now taken place wherein order dated 13.09.2019 has been passed by the Additional Superintending Engineer, Operation Division Estate (Special) Giaspura, Ludhiana, whereby the period of break w.e.f. 10.09.1999 to 20.03.2000 (193 days) and 21.03.2000 to 17.07.2000 (119 days) stands regularized. He contends that the appellant would approach the authorities in the light of the regularization of this period as this was the basic reason for denying the benefit of 9 and 16 years ACP Grade.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the

appellant, the present applications as well as the main appeal are permitted to be withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
