AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The writ petition filed by the Senior Vocational Staff Masters Association Ltd., was allowed on 27.04.2005. The respondents were directed to give benefit of notification dated 31.03.1995 to all Vocational Masters recruited prior to 08.07.1995 irrespective of the fact that whether they hold the qualification of degree in engineering or ITI diploma. The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Subhash Chander Mahajan, Deputy State Project Director, O/o Director General School

Education, Punjab has been filed today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. In pursuance to order dated 22.04.2019, a demand draft amounting to ₹5,000/-, as costs, has also been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that arrears of the petitioner has been calculated and amount found due has duly been credited in her bank account. The receipt is also annexed with the reply.

In view of reply filed, learned counsel for the petitioner states that though amount has been paid but detailed calculation has not been provided.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Raman Kalia, Superintendent, D.P.I., Mohali, states that detailed calculation of the amount will be communicated to the petitioner within six weeks from today.

In view of above, contempt petition is disposed of.

In case petitioner is aggrieved of the calculations, she would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

As the main petition is disposed of, the CM is rendered infructuous.
