Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks emergency parole for four weeks for performing the last rites ceremonies of his brother in view of Section 3(1) (a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988. He further contends that mother of the petitioner has moved an application dated 19.1.2019 (Annexure P-1), before the Jail Superintendent, Karnal. Petitioner was taken in police custody to attend the cremation of his younger brother namely Lavish who is stated to have died on 14.1.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that no order on the said application has been passed regarding parole for four weeks to perform the last rites ceremonies of his younger brother namely Lavish. His short prayer is for directing the authorities to decide the said application dated 19.1.2019 (Annexure P-1).
