Bay way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has made multiple prayers, but learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner confines her prayer to the extent of protection of her life and liberty only and would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to consider the representation dated 28.12.2018 (Annexure P-2) made by the petitioner regarding protection of her life and liberty only at the hands of private respondent No.4.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Jagmohan Ghumman, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Lest it may prejudice the rival claim of the parties, without making any observation on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the petitioner has confined her prayer qua protection of her “life and liberty only”, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-2) qua protection of “life and liberty only” of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent No.4 and to act in accordance with law.
