The short grievance raised by the petitioner in the instant writ petition is that his application seeking renewal of his arms license pertaining to two weapons is not being processed and finalized.

Counsel submits that the petitioner owns a .12 bore gun and .32 bore revolver and the arms license pertaining to these two weapons were issued in the year 1974 and has since been renewed periodically upto the year 2016.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Bhavna Gupta, learned DAG, Punjab accepts notice and waives service.

A complete copy of the writ petition has been furnished to learned State counsel.

Learned State counsel makes a statement that the application moved by the petitioner seeking renewal of his arms license would be dealt with in accordance with law and a final decision thereupon would be taken expeditiously and in any case within a period of two months from today.
