SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J.(Oral)

This is a revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside the impugned order dated 10.09.2018 passed by Ld. Additional District Judge, Amritsar.

Seen letter No.2 dated 28.11.2019, sent by Learned JMIC, Amritsar from which it transpires that the bus in question, has already been sold in auction.

In the circumstances, the revision at this stage is disposed off with a direction that the Auction proceeds be got deposited with the Learned MACT, before whom the execution proceedings are pending, which may, thereafter, deal with the same in accordance with law.

It is further submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that

his client would be willing to deposit the balance amount in the Executing Court in lieu of which his property under attachment be released. The petitioners are at liberty to move the learned Executive Court, to seek release of his property. The Auction Purchaser will also be at liberty to seek release of the bus, in question.
