On 03.12.2018, the case was adjourned on the concurrence of both the parties that there was every likelihood of the dispute being compromised before the probate Court.

Today both the parties are *ad idem* that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and the probate proceedings have been withdrawn on the basis of said settlement. There is a clause in the agreement that the civil suit filed by the plaintiffs/respondents would also be withdrawn.

Today, learned counsel for respondent No.1 states that

the civil suit filed by the plaintiffs shall be withdrawn on or before 24.01.2019 i.e. the date fixed before the trial Court.

In view of aforesaid, this revision petition is rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to get the petition revived in case the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.1 is not complied with.
