GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners – Maya and Dharminder Sharma have averred that they have married against wishes of respondent No.4, who is father of petitioner No.1. Petitioner No.1 has annexed copy of her Aadhar Card to the effect that she is aged 36 years and petitioner No.2 has copy of his passport indicating his age 32 years.
2. The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.4 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

3. The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any serious apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.
4. However, the aforesaid order shall not be taken to be any expression regarding validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
