In the present petition, the petitioner has challenged order dated 29.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) vide which his private complaint has been dismissed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amloh and order dated 26.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) vide which the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib has dismissed the revision petition.

2. According to the complaint, the accused person had stolen a receipt book of the Gurudwara and had un-authorizedly issued receipts. The money collected thereby had been misappropriated by him.

3. The learned courts below have found that the petitioner has described himself as the Ex-President of the Gurudwara Committee but there is nothing on record to indicate that he was ever the President of the said Committee. Moreover, there is evidence on record to show that the complainant's witness had produced the receipts allegedly issued by the accused and thus, it was concluded that even on merits no case had been prima facie established.

4. No meaningful argument has been raised by learned counsel for the petitioner to displace the aforementioned findings and thus, I do not find any ground to interfere therewith.
5. The petition is accordingly dismissed.
