Petitioners seek grant of Anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.185 dated 13.11.2018 under Sections 458, 323, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code 1860 registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that a compromise has been effected amongst the parties and petition for quashing of the FIR is also pending in this Court for 12.04.2019. The aforesaid position is not disputed by the learned State Counsel.

In view of the aforesaid fact that the parties have entered into an amicable settlement, the petition is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 25.01.2019 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do

so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
